Washington State's MEP helps provide services and support to migrant students and their families to help the students have what they need in school to be successful and graduate. Our goal at GCDS is to ensure program students reach academic standards and graduate in preparation for further learning, productive employment, and responsible citizenship.

Native migrant status is unique to the program as we are able to involve families whose lifeways in seasonal fishing and gathering, without moving out of the area for long periods of time, are recognized. These students qualify every three years with their family and will receive the support and services during this time. Enrollment in the program may provide these benefits:

- ❖ Free school meals
- ❖ Access to summer school programs
- ❖ Technical learning courses
- ❖ School year tutoring
- ❖ Supplemental English and Math studies
- ❖ Supplemental health and social supports
- ❖ Credit accrual for graduation
- ❖ Transfer of all school records in the event your family moves
