State Required Testing

Normally, students take state required testing, also known as the Smarter Balanced Assessment in the spring of each year. Due to Covid, testing was cancelled the last two years. It has been determined by the state that all students in grades 7, 8, 9, 11, and 12 will test this fall to make up for previous missed tests. The test has been shortened significantly from its original version. This important test will give us baseline information about the needs of our students. It is important for students to do their best.
