

ASB Athletics Revenue HB-1660

Proposal: In an effort to comply with above mentioned house bill, the Grand Coulee Dam School District would adopt a procedure regarding collection of fees from students and nonstudents as a condition to their attendance at, or participation in, any optional noncredit extracurricular event of the district which is of a cultural, social, recreational, or athletic nature: PROVIDED, that in so establishing such fee or fees, the district shall adopt a policy and regulations for waiving fees for students who are eligible to participate in the federal free or reduced-price meals program and for reducing such fees in the cases of those students whose families, by reason of their low income, would have difficulty in paying the entire amount of such fees and may likewise waive or reduce such fees for students' family members and other nonstudents of the age of sixty-five or over who, by reason of their low income, would have difficulty in paying the entire amount of such fees. An optional comprehensive fee may be established and collected for any combination or all of such events or, in the alternative, a fee may be established and collected as a condition to attendance at any single event. Fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the associated student body program fund of the school district, and may be expended to defray the costs of optional noncredit extracurricular events of such a cultural, social, recreational, or athletic nature, or to otherwise support the activities and programs of associated student bodies.

Policy: The Grand Coulee Dam School District will not charge an ASB card fee or sports participation fee for any student within the school district. The Associated Student Body will also adopt a policy to reduce the fee for entrance to events for students' family members and other nonstudents of the age of sixty-five or over who, by reason of their low income, would have difficulty in paying the entire amount of such fees.

Procedure:

1. Waive all ASB Card Fees for all students & eliminate all participation fees for athletics and non-credit extracurricular events including cost of participation and attendance for all students at regular season home events.
2. All Raider passes will be available at the HS office for purchase and will not be sold at the admission gate of events.
3. Admission rates will be set annually by the ASB no later than June 15th.
4. ASB - Proposed Admission rates for events for 2022/23 season:
 - \$8.00 - Adults
 - \$6.00- Visiting Students/Senior Citizens
 - Annual Family Pass- \$150
 - Senior Citizen/Reduced Family Pass- \$75 -
(The reduced pass would be a savings of \$600 for a couple)
 - All passes would include names of family members covered by the annual/reduced pass
